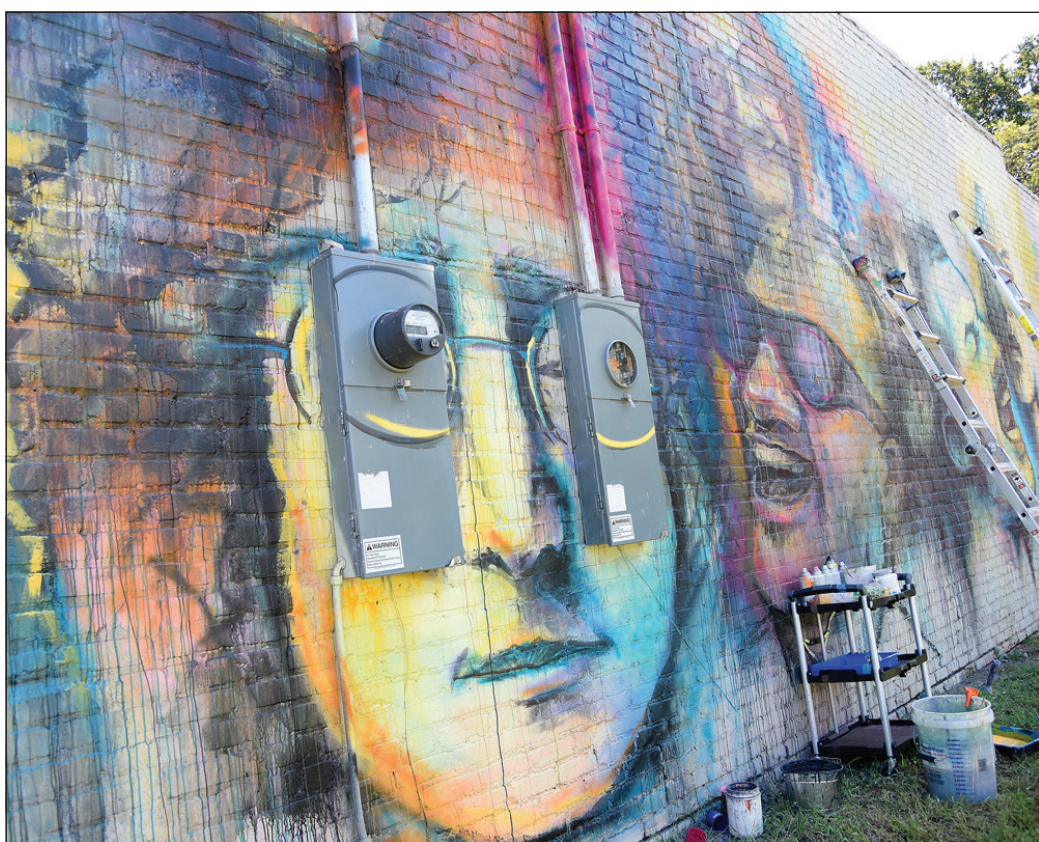


Artist Brian Davis incorporated the electrical power meters into his portrait of musician John Lennon.

of the mural quickly, and to get new color variations, he said.

The subjects themselves are unique, too. He purposefully added diversity to the wall to represent not only a variety of musical talents and races, but a variety of lifestyles.

So far, the mural has garnered support from passersby.

"I have people who sit along the street and just watch, like they're watching TV," Davis said.

Jeff Horney, executive director of Theatre Art Galleries, also stopped by Tuesday afternoon "just to check in," he said, watching Davis at work. TAG had hosted a mural competition in April that Davis entered.

"Looks great," he said, watching Davis move a brush along Joplin's forehead.

Davis said he and others in the city are building what they hope to call a "Mural Mile." It would channel people through the major

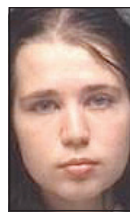

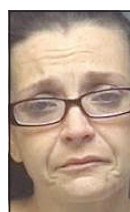
